

# HOW TO RESET GAS

## METER

Modern gas meters when they lose the signal to the electric meter will cut off your gas as a safety feature.

This is not a common occurrence but one that does occur occasionally.

To identify and reset your meter is an easy process.

### IF YOUR BOILER WILL NOT LIGHT AND,

- Fault code showing F2, L2, E133, 133, F28, F29, EA
- No gas to the Hob Or fire

### IF YOU LIVE IN A FLAT

- The Emergency gas valve hasn't been knocked in the off position in error (If it is located under the kitchen sink or in a cupboard this could be the cause)



### LOCATE YOUR GAS METER BOX

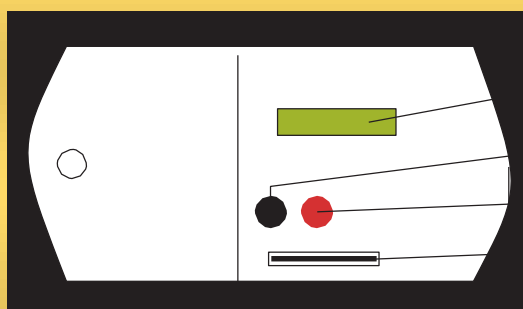


### OPEN THE THE METER BOX AND FOLLOW ON SCREEN INSTRUCTIONS

- Push button B to show status (screen will say no credit, push button A for credit)
- Then push button A for gas (as instructed on screen, to release gas)

### RESET BOILER

- Pushing a reset button
- Turning down the dial to off and back on
- Or turning the switch on the wall to cut the power and then back on.

NOTE: Though you may not have a prepaid meter, the display will still show no credit, until you push button A.
